Dancers are required at: **8:30am for Primary & Beginners**, starting with Highland Fling
8:30am for Premier & Intermediate, starting with Sailors' Hornpipe
9:15am for Novice, starting with 4 step Highland Fling
Primary dancers will be finished mid-morning.
Beginners dancers only dancing the two Flings will be finished late morning.

COMPETITION RULES

1. This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc (S.Q.R.C.H.D.I.) – Reg.No. SQC 22/05. This competition will be conducted under the rules and conditions of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (R.S.O.B.H.D) and as adopted by the Australian Board of Highland Dancing Inc (A.B.H.D.I.).
2. Dancers are to compete in their own age group and in one classification only. If, after submitting an entry, a competitor changes classification, please notify hdcomps on admin@hdcomps.com or Bernadette at bernadetteshdc@hotmail.com PRIOR to the competition date (1st May 2022).
3. Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or adjudication of an event must be made in writing, giving the complainants full name and address, and shall be lodged with the organiser (if possible on the day of the event) not later than 48 hours after the event. Such a complaint to be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00 which is refundable if protest is upheld.
4. Subject to the official protest rule above, the Adjudicator's decision is final.
5. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
6. COVID-19: The Organisers of this competition will abide by all national and state regulations in force at the time of conducting this competition. Attendees must follow all requests provided by the Organisers with regards to COVID-safe practices.
7. Competitors arriving late for a dance will not be allowed to compete if the section has been completed or pre-dance prior to the commencement of the section.
8. Teachers, interested parties or any other unauthorised person must not communicate with judges during a competition. All enquiries must be made at the official table.
9. During the course of the competition the comportment and behaviour of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification. A full report of any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judge to the organiser. In serious cases, the judge should also provide a report of any such conduct on the part of the competitor to the organiser and to the SOBHD. (*Rule 1g, p42 D-Judges, SOBHD Rules and Regulations*)
10. The committee reserves the right to appoint substitute adjudicators and/or alter the program.
11. For presentation of prizes on stage, dancers must be in kilt or national costume. Competitor's number must be worn.
12. Definitely NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY will be allowed whilst the dancers are competing.
13. VIDEO EQUIPMENT ... It is prohibited to use any device capable of recording or transmitting visual images without the organiser's permission.
14. **NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED AT THE COMPETITION VENUE.**
15. TITLES ... Dancers may choose to compete in all or some of the individual dances that make up a Title and will still be eligible for an overall title prize – however the full title fee will still apply. Individual prizes in each title dance will be awarded.
16. ENTRIES CLOSE ... We would appreciate all entries to be accepted by 6th April. However, we will accept late entries. Age groups will be decided on 13th April 2022.
