PLEASE NOTE CHANGE OF NUMBER OF STEPS

Section Dances and Trophy Dance ONLY Will Be Danced As Separate Sections Premier And Premier With Restriction.

Premier with Restriction is restricted to Premier dancers who have not previously been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd overall in a Registered Championship. Dancers entered in Premier with Restriction dances are not eligible to compete in any other classification in the same dance.

TROPHY DANCE: Sailors' Hornpipe (5 steps)

SECTION DANCES: Scottish Lilt (4 steps); Barracks Johnnie (4 steps) and Highland Laddie (4 steps)

"The Elsie Innes Barker Cup for Characterisation of the Jig/Hornpipe" (Premier)

The Rob Roy MacGregor Shield will be awarded jointly by adjudicators, to a dancer competing in Premier dances who clearly demonstrates the "Spirit of the Dance" as an encouragement to further the "Spirit" of Highland Dancing.

The Ron Scott Dancer of the Day, a perpetual trophy, will be awarded jointly by the adjudicators, to a Premier dancer for their outstanding performance over all dances and all age levels.

MARY CAMPBELL SCHOLARSHIP

Over the next two years, both Thistle and MacGregor competitions will award The Mary Campbell Scholarship, an amount of \$250.00 to be selected by the judges at each competition to assist in that dancer's future development in Highland Dancing - either through tuition, workshops, seminars, travel to competitions or for other dancing essentials. At this year's Thistle Competition and Macgregor Competition, the judges will be selecting a Premier dancer to be awarded the scholarship.

- Premier dancer has advised they are 'Restricted' and is then placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd overall in a registered Championship

CHOREOGRAPHY RULES

- Teams should consist of
- One school only or
- More than one school, in which case, the teacher/choreographer must abide by the three-month teaching/judging rule.
- Content should consist primarily of movements from Highland, National, Hornpipe and Jig books.
- A maximum time limit of 2 minutes for solo; 3 minutes for duo; 3 minutes for a group of 3 and 4 minutes for a group of 4 or more has been set to include entrance and exit of competitors and the setting up/removal of props.
- Teams may use props during their performance, either static or non-static, but live animals are not permitted.
- Music may be live or pre-recorded and may include vocal or percussion selections, but in ALL
 cases must be PREDONIMANTLY Scottish or Celtic in style. Music must be provided to
 organiser on day of competition, either on USB or blue tooth enabled device (NO CDs).
- Costumes must follow theme and content of the item.
- Judges must be from the current RSOBHD, ABHDI, OBHDA(SA) Judges panel. The number
 of judges must be 1 or 3 to comply with the current scrutineering system. A total mark should
 be awarded. No separate prizes for costumes etc.
- Entries must be accompanied by entry fees and late entries will be accepted. Entries received after closing date may not appear in the program.
