# **Competition Rules**

- 1. This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc. (Reg. No. SQC2023/07) and will be conducted under the rules and conditions as set down by RSOBHD and as adopted by ABHDI.
- 2. Dancers must be registered and present their registration card on the day of the competition.
- 3. Age to be taken as at the date of competition.
- 4. Pre-Premier Eligibility for Pre-Premier sections will apply as at the date of competition and shall be in accordance with RSOBHD Registration Scheme.
- 5. RESTRICTED PREMIER Eligibility in this section is defined as a Premier dancer who has not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a Registered Championship since 1/1/19.
- 6. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
- 7. Dancers entering sections when ineligible shall forfeit their entry fee.
- 8. Competitors arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if that section has been completed.
- 9. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, substitute a Judge and/or alter the programme at their discretion.
- 10. Subject to the official protest ruling, the Judge's decision is final.
- 11. Any complaint made by an individual against the Organisation or the adjudication of an event must be made in writing stating the complainant's full name and address and be lodged with the Organiser, if possible, on the day of the event, and not later than 48 hours after the event. The complaint must be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00, which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
- 12. For the presentation of prizes, dancers MUST be in Kilt or National Costume. Numbers must be worn for the prize-giving ceremony.
- 13. Photography: Unauthorised use of cameras, imaging and digital devices is prohibited, including recording using mobile phones. It is prohibited to use any device capable of recording or transmitting visual images without the organiser's permission. Following the awards parents may photograph their own child or other children with parental permission but be highly aware that there must not be other children in shot whose privacy must be protected. (If applicable) As organisers of this event, we plan to photograph winning competitors for the purpose of posting on our Website or Facebook page. If anyone wishes to opt out of this process, please let us know.
- 14. If after submitting an entry a competitor changes in classification: Prior to 21 July 2023 please notify hdcomps on admin@hdcomps.com on or after 21 July 2023 please notify competition secretary on <a href="mailto:reeltoroma@gmail.com">reeltoroma@gmail.com</a> All changes must be finalised PRIOR to competition day.
- 15. NO SMOKING allowed in Competition Venue.
- 16. The ABHDI direct that dancers use dressing rooms to change costume, and to dress fully, appropriately and respectably when in public at competitions.
- 17. ENTRIES CLOSE 21 July 2023. No entries will be accepted after the closing date.
- 18. All entries are to be submitted via hdcomps.com Email or telephone entries will not be accepted.
- 19. Any rules pertaining to competition or Championship, released by RSOBHD or ABHDI from the time of printing this schedule to the date of the Competition or Championship, will be adhered to.
- 20. Entry fees (excluding admin fees) are fully refundable prior to 21 July 2023. After this time, refunds (excluding admin fees) will only be given on production of a medical certificate or at the discretion of the Reel to Roma Committee. The Competition Secretary must be advised in writing prior to the event. No refunds will be given if a dancer does not meet the criteria above or does not compete on the day.
- 21. During the course of a competition the comportment and behaviour of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification. A full report of any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judges to the organiser. In serious cases, the judge should also provide a report of any such conduct on the part of the competitor to the organiser and to the RSOBHD.
