RULES AND REGULATIONS: 15/06/2024

1. THIS COMPETITION IS REGISTERED WITH THE SOUTH QUEENSLAND REGIONAL COMMITTEE OF HIGHLAND DANCING INC. REG. NO. SQC 2024/06 AND WILL BE CONDUCTED UNDER THE RULES AND CONDITIONS AS SET DOWN BY RSOBHD AND ADOPTED BY ABHDI.
2. DANCERS MUST BE REGISTERED AND PRESENT REGISTRATION CARD ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION.
3. AGE TO BE TAKEN AS AT DATE OF COMPETITION (SQC 2024/06 - 15/06/2024).
4. DANCERS ARE TO COMPETE IN THEIR OWN AGE GROUP AND ONE CLASSIFICATION ONLY.
5. DANCER ORDER WILL BE DETERMINED BY A RANDOM DRAW ON THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES AND ANY ENTRIES RECEIVED THEREAFTER WILL BE ADDED TO THE BEGINNING OF THE SECTION.
6. PRE-PREMIER - ELIGIBILITY FOR PRE-PREMIER SECTION WILL APPLY AS AT DATE OF COMPETITION AND SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH RSOBHD REGISTRATION SCHEME.
7. TITLES - DANCERS MAY CHOOSE NOT TO COMPETE IN ALL DANCES THAT MAKE UP THE TITLE AND STILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR AN OVERALL TITLE PRIZE, HOWEVER, THE FULL TITLE FEE STILL APPLIES.
8. DANCERS COMPETE ENTIRELY AT THEIR OWN RISK.
9. DANCERS ARRIVING LATE FOR A SECTION WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE IF THE DANCE HAS BEEN COMPLETED. ALTERNATIVELY, COMPETITORS MAY NOT PRE-DANCE PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF A SECTION.
10. DANCERS MUST 'FILL IN' IF REQUESTED BY THE ORGANISER. IF A COMPETITOR FAILS TO FILL IN UNLESS FOR A MEDICAL REASON THE ORGANISER HAS THE RIGHT TO ENFORCE RULE 16), PAGE 45 D-JUDGES, RSOBHD RULES AND REGULATIONS, WHICH READS: 'DURING THE COURSE OF A COMPETITION THE COMPORTMENT AND BEHAVIOUR OF THE COMPETITORS MAY COME UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE JUDGES, NOT ONLY WHILST DANCING, BUT ALSO WHEN ENTERING OR LEAVING THE PLATFORM AND WHILST WAITING FOR THE DANCE TO START. ANY UNSEEMLY BEHAVIOUR ON THE PART OF A COMPETITOR OR ANY MISDEMEANOUR LIKELY TO UPSET THE DECORUM OF THE PROCEEDINGS MAY BE PENALISED BY THE JUDGES AND COULD LEAD TO DISQUALIFICATION. A FULL REPORT OF ANY SUCH MISCONDUCT ON THE PART OF A COMPETITOR MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE JUDGE TO THE ORGANISER. IN SERIOUS CASES, THE JUDGE SHOULD ALSO PROVIDE A REPORT OF ANY SUCH CONDUCT ON THE PART OF THE COMPETITOR TO THE ORGANISER AND TO THE RSOBHD'.
11. DANCERS ENTERING SECTIONS WHEN INELIGIBLE SHALL FORFEIT THEIR ENTRY FEE.
12. THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRIES, SUBSTITUTE AN ADJUDICATOR AND/OR ALTER THE PROGRAM AT THEIR DISCRETION.
13. SUBJECT TO THE OFFICIAL PROTEST RULING, THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.
14. ANY COMPLAINT MADE BY AN INDIVIDUAL AGAINST THE ORGANISATION OR THE ADJUDICATION OF AN EVENT MUST BE IN WRITING STATING THE COMPLAINANT'S FULL NAME AND ADDRESS AND BE LODGED WITH THE ORGANISER, IF POSSIBLE ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT, AND NO LATER THAN 48 HOURS AFTER THE EVENT. SUCH A COMPLAINT IS TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY A FEE OF \$5.00, WHICH IS REFUNDABLE IF THE PROTEST IS UPHOLD.
15. FOR PRESENTATION OF PRIZES, DANCERS MUST BE IN KILT OR NATIONAL COSTUME. COMPETITION NUMBERS MUST BE WORN FOR PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY.
16. VIDEO EQUIPMENT AND PHOTOGRAPHY - DEFINITELY NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY IS ALLOWED WHILST DANCERS ARE COMPETING. VIDEOING IS PERMITTED WITH THE FOLLOWING PROVISO - ONLY OWN CHILD OR PUPIL CAN BE FILMED AND AT NO TIME WILL THE FILM OR VIDEO BE ACCEPTED AS EVIDENCE WHEN PROTESTING JUDGING. UNAUTHORISED USE OF CAMERAS, IMAGING AND DIGITAL DEVICES IS PROHIBITED, INCLUDING RECORDED USING MOBILE PHONES. IT IS PROHIBITED TO USE ANY DEVICE CAPABLE OF RECORDING OR TRANSMITTING VISUAL IMAGES WITHOUT THE ORGANISER'S PERMISSION. FOLLOWING THE AWARDS, PARENTS/CARERS MAY PHOTOGRAPH THEIR OWN CHILD OR OTHER CHILDREN WITH PARENTAL PERMISSION BUT MUST BE HIGHLY AWARE THAT THERE MUST NOT BE OTHER CHILDREN IN SHOT WHOSE PRIVACY MUST BE PROTECTED. AS ORGANISERS OF THIS EVENT, WE PLAN TO PHOTOGRAPH COMPETITORS FOR THE PURPOSE OF POSTING ON OUR WEBSITE AND/OR FACEBOOK PAGE. IF ANYONE WISHES TO OPT OUT OF THIS PROCESS, PLEASE ADVISE THE ORGANISER.
17. IF AFTER SUBMITTING AN ENTRY A COMPETITOR CHANGES CLASSIFICATION, THE ENTRIES SECRETARY MUST BE NOTIFIED, AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE, PRIOR TO COMPETITION DAY.
18. ANY RULES PERTAINING TO THE COMPETITION AND/OR CHAMPIONSHIP RELEASED FROM RSOBHD AND ABHDI FROM TIME OF PRINTING THIS SCHEDULE AND ACTUAL DATE OF COMPETITION WILL BE ADHERED TO.
19. COMPETITORS MUST USE THE OFFICIAL MUSIC AND SWORDS PROVIDED BY THE COMMITTEE.
20. NO WARM-UP OR PRACTICING IS PERMITTED WITHIN VIEW OF THE STAGE WHILST DANCERS ARE COMPETING.
21. SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED INSIDE WHILST INSIDE THE SCHOOL GROUNDS.
22. DANCERS ARE REQUESTED TO OBSERVE THE ABHDI DIRECTION REGARDING STANDARD OF DRESS WHILST IN ATTENDANCE AT HIGHLAND DANCING COMPETITIONS. IF DANCERS CHOOSE TO REMOVE ANY PART OF THEIR COSTUME WHILST NOT COMPETING, IT IS REQUESTED THEY BE MODESTLY ATTIRED AT ALL TIMES.
23. REID SCHOOL OF HIGHLAND DANCE IS NOT LIABLE FOR THE SAFETY OF UNACCOMPANIED DANCERS AND UNSUPERVISED NON-DANCERS.
24. REID SCHOOL OF HIGHLAND DANCE'S RISK MANAGEMENT STRATEGY WILL BE ENFORCED AND WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR ANYONE WHO WISHES TO PERUSE THIS DOCUMENT.
25. ENTRY FEES (EXCLUDING ADMIN FEES) ARE FULLY REFUNDABLE PRIOR TO 15TH MAY 2024. AFTER THIS TIME, REFUNDS (EXCLUDING ADMIN FEES) WILL ONLY BE GIVEN ON PRODUCTION OF A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE AND IF THE COMPETITION SECRETARY IS ADVISED IN WRITING PRIOR TO THE EVENT. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN IF A DANCER DOES NOT MEET THE CRITERIA ABOVE OR DOES NOT COMPETE ON THE DAY.
26. REID SCHOOL OF HIGHLAND DANCE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DEAL WITH ANY MATTER NOT COVERED BY THESE RULES.
27. ALL PERPETUAL TROPHY WINNERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN FOR THESE TROPHIES AND MUST ABIDE BY THE STATED CONDITIONS AS LAID OUT IN THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS DOCUMENT PROVIDED AT THE COMPETITION.
31. COVID-19: THE ORGANISERS OF THIS COMPETITION WILL ABIDE BY ALL NATIONAL AND STATE REGULATIONS IN FORCE AT THE TIME OF CONDUCTING THIS COMPETITION. ATTENDEES MUST FOLLOW ALL REQUESTS PROVIDED BY THE ORGANISERS WITH REGARDS TO COVID SAFE PRACTICES.
